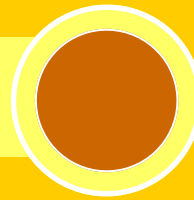
## Developing Culturally Relevant Language Teaching Guides, Activities and Materials Workshop

Participants will develop language activities (lesson plans) and language materials. This is a very hands-on training workshop.
