The Indigenous Language Institute (ILI) was founded in 1992 as a publicly supported 501(C)3 non-profit organization based in Santa Fe, New Mexico. ILI is a majority Native American and Indigenous led organization, with the Staff and Board of Directors representing nations from across North America.



The mission of the Indigenous Language Institute (ILI) is to provide vital language related services to Native American nations, tribes, and communities so that their individual identities, traditional wisdom and values pare passed on to future generations in their original languages.

There is urgency to revitalize Native languages as the small population of Elder spearkers is rapidly declining. ILI's guiding philosophy is to assist communities to create speakers of the endangered languages that are USED in daily life by all generations.

About the Language Symposium

The Indigenous Language Symposium (ILIS), hosted by the Indigenous Language Institute (ILI) annually, has become a cornerstone for Indigenous language revitalization efforts. In 2024, the Symposium achieved a record turnout of over 300 attendees, representing more than 100 tribal nations from across the United States. This gathering fosters collaboration, knowledge-sharing, and inspiration among participants from diverse Indigenous communities, uniting them in a shared commitment to preserving their languages and cultural identity.

The Symposium serves as a platform where presenters including academics, community leaders, language practitioners, educators, and advocates—share community practices, research, personal experiences, and professional success stories. These presentations address critical challenges in language revitalization, such as the dwindling number of Elder speakers, limited resources, and the need to ensure intergenerational language transmission.

This year's theme, "*The Healing Power of Language*," emphasizes the profound role Indigenous languages play in fostering identity, resilience, and well-being. The Symposium exemplifies ILI's commitment to empowering Indigenous communities to reclaim, strengthen, and sustain their languages. This year, we are excited to add the Youth Language Symposium, which aligns with the theme and focuses on bridging connections between generations in language learning, ensuring the vitality of languages for the future.


