Workshop Overview

*Note: You can attend this workshop, even if you did not attend Part 1 & 2. Community Engagement from all levels – individuals, families, work forces, leadership – and all ages is critical to the success in revitalizing our Native Languages.

This three-day training will share strategies that can involve everyone to enjoy and celebrate using our Language in daily life. The workshop is for community members of all ages who are interested in normalizing use of our Native Language in daily life. Community members may understand how important it is to keep our Language vibrant, but they require skills and tools to implement strategies to bring Language use back to daily life. The training session focuses on: activities that promote use of language; building confidence in using Language; immersion strategies and tools for families.

Participants will have ample time to practice and apply what they learned in a participatory and interactive setting.

Participants will be required to develop and share mini-lessons that apply what they learned. Full three-day participation is required for Certificate of Completion.

Recommended for language practitioners, advocates, teachers and staff of all grade levels (preschool to college), program directors, school administrators, school principals, parents, caregivers, tribal leaders and community members.
